New Definitions

- **Central Accumulation Area**
 - Previously known as: “90-Day” or “180-Day” waste accumulation areas
- **Large Quantity Generator**
 - Was not officially defined
 - Greater than or equal to 1,000 kilograms of non-acute hazardous waste; **or** greater than 1 kilogram of acute hazardous waste; **or** greater than 1 kilogram of extremely hazardous waste
- **Non-Acute Hazardous Waste**
 - Waste that is not acute or extremely hazardous waste

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Modified Definitions

- **Very Small Quantity Generator**
 - Previously known as Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator
- **Small Quantity Generator**
 - Generates less than 1,000 kilograms of non-acute hazardous waste; **and** less than or equal to 1 kilogram of acute hazardous waste; **and** less than or equal to 1 kilogram of extremely hazardous waste, in a calendar month.
- **Acutely Hazardous Waste**
 - Specifically citing the sections where the acutely hazardous wastes are listed

Generator Status Re-notification

- **SQGs of RCRA hazardous waste** are required to re-notify DTSC using EPA Form 8700-12
- **LQGs of RCRA hazardous waste** are required to re-notify DTSC using EPA Form 8700-12

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Re-notification

RCRA SQG

- **When:** started 2024
- **Due Date:** September 1st
- **Frequency:** Every four years

RCRA LQG

- **When:** starting 2026
- **Due Date:** March 1st
- **Frequency:** Every two years
- May submit Form 8700-12 as a part of the biennial report (Form 8700-13 A/B)

Tank Labeling and Marking

Tank Labeling and Marking

- Mark the tank with hazards of the content of the tank

Where is it located?

State: 22 CCR 66262.16(b)(4)(B),
66262.17(a)(5)(B)

Tank Labeling and Marking (Continued)

- Use inventory logs, monitoring equipment, or other records to demonstrate
 - a tank has been emptied within 180 days of first entering the tank, or
 - estimated volumes of hazardous waste entering the tank daily exit the tank within 180 days of first entering
- Keep record of accumulation and emptied date on site

Special Conditions for Ignitable or Reactive Wastes

Special Conditions for Ignitable or Reactive Wastes

- LQGs
- Take precautions to prevent accidental ignition or reaction
- Separate ignitable and reactive wastes from ignition sources such as heat, flames, etc.
- Place “No Smoking” sign in hazard areas
- Confine smoking and open flames to designated locations

Pre-Transportation Marking

Pre-Transportation Marking

- Before transporting the waste, generators must mark their containers with **EPA waste number**
- Example D008 for lead

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Incompatible Wastes in Satellite Accumulation Area

Incompatible Wastes in SAA

Three requirements for incompatible wastes in SAA:

- Incompatible waste/material **must not be placed** in the same container
- Hazardous waste **must not** be placed in an unwashed container that previously held an incompatible waste/material
- A container holding an incompatible waste/material must be **separated** from the other materials or wastes by any practical means (example: a dike, berm, wall, etc.)

Closure Requirements for Large Quantity Generators

LQG Waste Accumulation Area/Unit Closure

New requirements:

1. Closure requirements for **container** waste accumulation area/unit
2. **Notification** requirements for closure of waste accumulation area/unit (containers, containment buildings, tanks, and drip pads)

Where is it located?

22 CCR 66262.17(a)(8) and
22 CCR 66262.17(a)(8)(A)

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LQG Waste Accumulation Area/Unit Closure

Option 1

Place a notice in the operating record within 30 days after closure identifying the location of the unit.

Option 2

Meet the closure performance standards and **notify** the Department within 90 days after closing using U.S. EPA Form 8700-12.



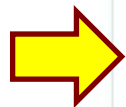

4. If generator cannot remove contaminated soil or waste, then the waste accumulation unit or facility is considered to be a landfill and perform post-closure care.

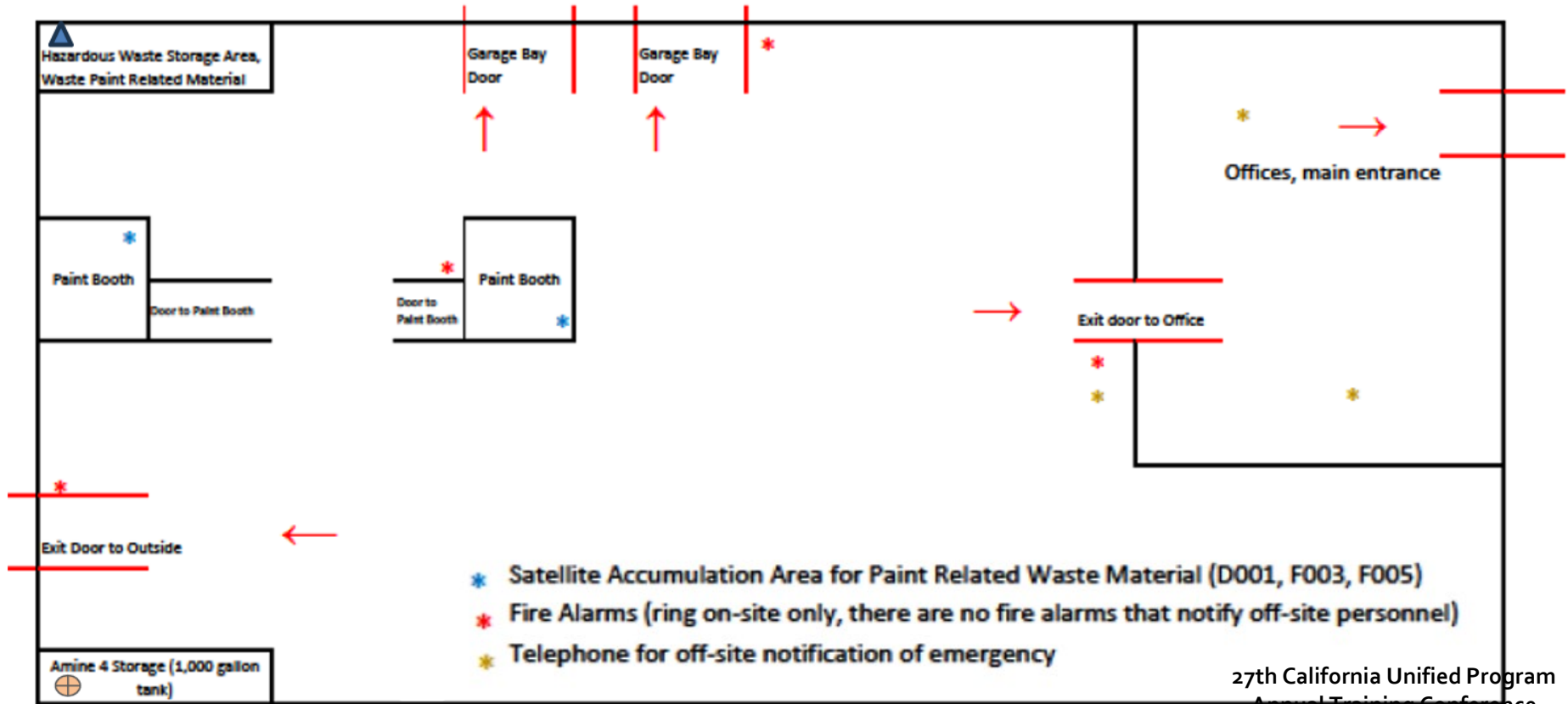
